History of Water of Life Lutheran Church



In the early 2000's, a group of Lutheran followers of Jesus began to gather to pray, study the Scriptures, and contemplate the planting of a Lutheran congregation in Forney, Texas. In consultation with Mission and Ministry Facilitator Paul Krentz and supported by the congregations of Circuit 12 of the Texas District LCMS, this group began to hold weekly worship services on Easter Sunday, 2005 in the Forney High School cafeteria. In the early days of their life together, the people of Water of Life were especially supported by the Rev. Thomas Thierfelder and the people of Tree of Life, Garland.

The Rev. James Jarrett was installed as planting pastor on June 18, 2006. On the Festival of the Reformation, October 29, 2006, Water of Life Evangelical Lutheran Church of Forney, Texas ("WOL") chartered as a member congregation in the Texas District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod with twenty-one charter members.

After a year in the high school cafeteria followed by three years of worshiping in a chapel rented from First Baptist Church of Forney, WOL purchased land on F.M. 1641 dedicating its first building to the glory of God on June 6, 2010. Since then, the congregation has grown to fill its facilities with three Sunday worship services, including a Spanish-speaking service, Sunday School classes for all ages, annual Vacation Bible School, and many gatherings for study, fellowship, and service throughout the year. Our current pastor, Rev. Shawn Deterding, was installed on November 10, 2019. We are blessed by his servant heart and leadership as we look to the future to continue to grow in faith and serve those in our community.

WOL is a congregation *in* our community *for* our community. Two ways we love and serve others are through Lucy's Prayer Shawl Ministry ("LPS") and our Food Pantry. Participants in LPS create crocheted shawls, hats, blankets, and toys for children and adults in any kind of need. These items are lovingly made, prayed over, and sent to people around the country. We regularly receive thank you cards from lives touched through their love and prayers. Our Food Pantry ministry provides grocery assistance to families in need in Kaufman County. Each month, our Food Pantry is blessed to serve approximately 35 families totaling over 90 individuals with canned and dry goods, and oftentimes fresh dairy and produce.



Christ Jesus is in our midst! He is and ever shall be! From Jesus' living presence among us, the people of WOL continue to grow in faith in God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, in fellowship and celebration with one another, and in service to the people of Forney and Kaufman County.
