<sup>33</sup>and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."


<sup>34</sup>And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?"

For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." <sup>3</sup>When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him; <sup>4</sup>and assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. <sup>5</sup>They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it is written by the prophet: <sup>6</sup>'And you, O

Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel."

# SECOND ARTICLE OF THE APOSTLES' CREED

- P Let us confess our faith by speaking together the Second Article of the Apostles' Creed.




